REPORT OF DIRECTOR OF INTEGRATED COMMISSIONING

1. Purpose

The purpose of this report is to update members of the Health & Care Integrated Commissioning Board on the development of integrated commissioning across the Council and the CCG.

2. Section 75

The agreement that was agreed in 2016/17 has now been fully reviewed and a set of revisions agreed between both parties. The existing agreement has been extended until the end of August 2017 to enable sufficient time for the required changes to be documented within a revised agreement and signed.

3. Stockport Together Update

Each of the outline business cases have now been considered by the five partner organisations. Each organisation has endorsed the cases and a number of caveats and issues have been identified. A plan to address these and move to the next stage is now being developed and the HCICB will be updated at a future meeting.

4. Mental Health Strategy

An informal HCICB considered the mental health strategy development, and considered the issues and proposed timescales. This was a very positive discussion and the comments and views of the HCICB will inform the next draft of the strategy which will be considered at a future HCICB meeting.

5. MCP

The MCP procurement continues to progress. Following the conclusion of the assessment panel process there have been a number of productive meetings with the provider alliance to gain further detail and assurance on the proposals, in particular the issues of clinical leadership and how mental health services will be embedded. It is anticipated that this stage of the procurement will be concluded in September and a further update subsequently provided to the HCICB.
